- ♦ **Community**—Who lives in your community? How does your church best reach those who live closest to your church? Eric Bryant, Director of New Church Development, will share how Mission Insite helps your church learn your community and then Patty Groot, Pastor of Outreach at Christ UMC, Louisville, will share how Fresh Expressions might be an opportunity to reach your neighbors. Patty leads two Fresh Expression worship communities in the West End of Louisville focusing on recovery
- ♦ **Discipleship**—The purpose of the church is to make disciples of Jesus Christ. However, most of us struggle to know what exactly it means to be a disciple, much less how do you make one? Jim Fant, pastor of Trinity UMC, will share the process of how you can grow in your own discipleship, as well as, how do you help disciple others. Tami Coleman, Associate Director of Connectional Ministries, will lead in how your church can increase its effectiveness in making disciples
- ♦ **Worship**—Worship is still the main focus of our churches on a weekly basis. Chuck Bell, who has lead worship in all size UM churches for 35 years, will share practices for clergy and lay in planning and implementing inspiring worship. Chuck led our worship at Annual Conference in June and brings a wealth of resources and experience.
